TENDER CALL NOTICE FOR AUCTION SALE OF THE VEHICLE NO- OR05H-5555 (TATA SUMO)

Sealed tenders in the plain paper are invited by the undersigned for disposal/auction sale of this office vehicle bearing Regd. Nos. OR05H-555(TATA SUMO) as *is where basis is*. The intending bidder may inspect the vehicle in the Testing Track Sector-6, CDA, Cuttack on any working days during office hours. Sealed tender paper should be deposited in the sealed tender box kept in this office, accompanying earnest money of Rs.2000/- (Rupees two thousand) only in shape of Bank Draft drawn in favour of Transport Commissioner, Odisha payable at State Bank of India, Main Branch, Cuttack & ID proof.. No bid shall be entertained unless it is accompanied with the earnest money & ID proof. The earnest money received from the bidders shall not bear any interest and will be refunded to unsuccessful bidders.

The tender should reach latest by...17.2.17...**up to 2.00 PM** and there after no bid will be entertained. The bids received shall be opened by the Tender Committee on the same day i.e. on...17.2.17... **at 3.00pm** in the office chamber of the ACT (Admn).

The highest bidder, whose tender will be accepted, shall deposit 25% of the bid amount after the auction is confirmed and shall deposit balance amount there after adjusting the earnest money within seven day from the acceptance of the tender.

The successful bidder shall take the vehicle from the aforesaid premises alongwith necessary documents within seven days from the date of depositing the full bid amount and beyond that date, the undersigned shall not be responsible for the safeguard of the vehicle. No claim on this account shall be entertained. In case bidder fails to deposit total amount of bid money within the stipulated date deposit made including the earnest money shall be forfeited.

On failure to remove the vehicle within the stipulated time, ground rent @ 1% (one percent) of the total bid amount shall be charged for each day or part thereof till removal of the vehicle or thirty day whichever is earlier. If ground rent exceeds the sale price deposited by the bidder, bidder shall have no right on the vehicle and the amount so deposited by him shall be adjusted towards the ground rent and the vehicle shall become absolute property of Govt. free from encumbrance and shall be disposed of by inviting fresh tender as the case may be.
