CONSIDERATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR STAGE CARRIAGE PERMITS ON
INTER-DISTRICT ROUTE (SINGLE APPLICATION)

ITEM NO.3.1:K.JAGAGUDA TO ERUKUBADI & ERUKUBADI TO KUMBHARIPUT
AND BACK

Pursuant to the advertisement published in Daily Odia News Paper "The Samaj & Sambad & English News Paper "The New Indian Express" dtd.21.01.2018. Sri Jagannath Pradhan, owner of vehicle No.OR07C-4701 has applied for grant of Permanent Permit on the above mentioned notified route. The vacancy arose due to surrender of Permanent Permit in respect of vehicle OR07C-4701 on the aforementioned route.

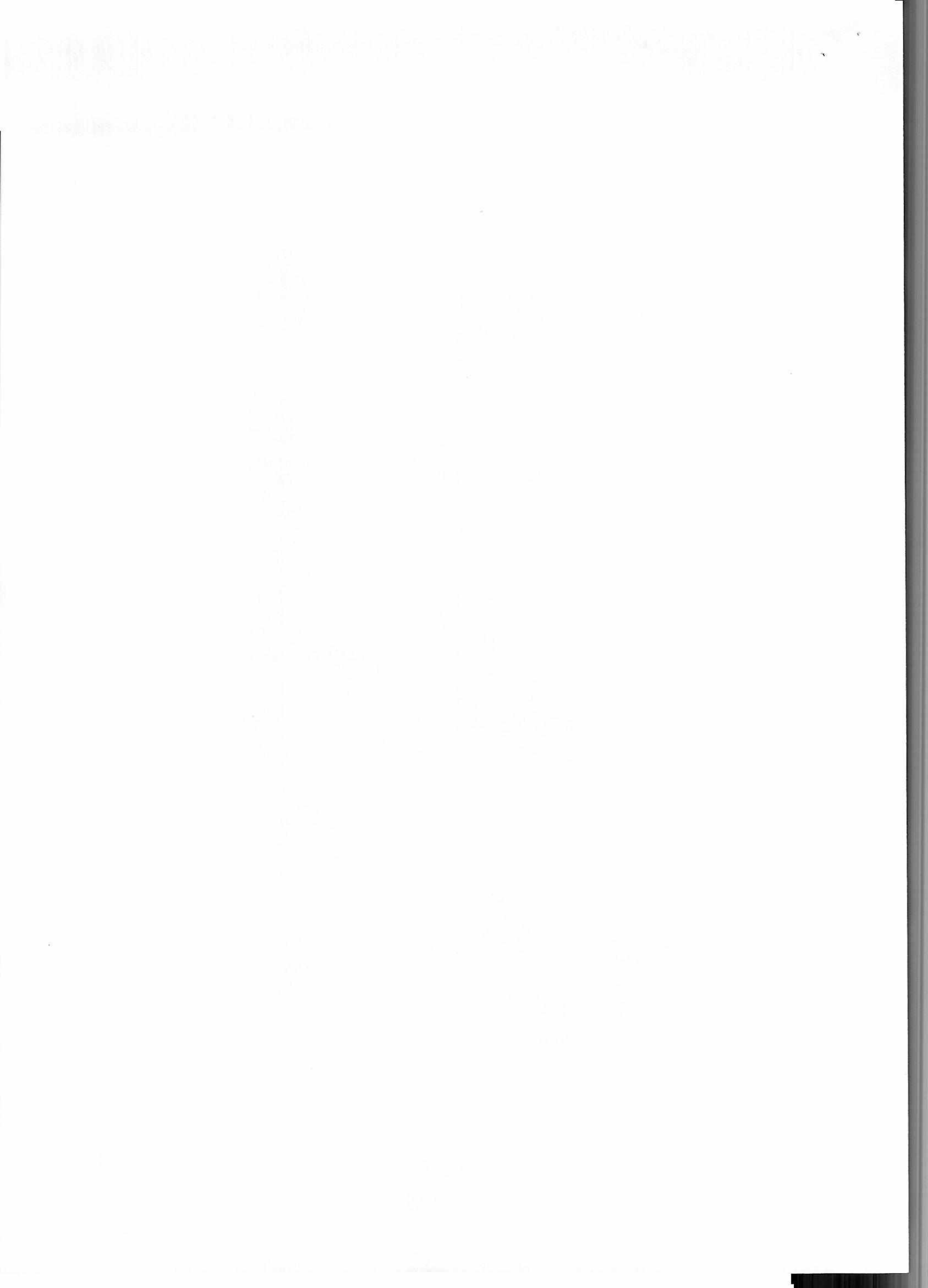


