ORDER

Authorised Pollution Testing Centers are issuing Pollution Under Control Certificate to different categories of vehicle and collecting fees under Rule 129-A of OMVT Rules, 1993. As per clarification issued by the Joint Commissioner CT & GST vide letter No.14582 dated 04.11.2019, the Authorised Pollution Testing Centers will collect GST @ 18% on fees charged by them. They will have to register themselves under GST Act and to issue GST invoice indicating the GST component separately. Therefore, it is mandatory on the part of every Authorised Pollution Testing Center to obtain GST registration for issuance of Pollution Under Control Certificate and collect GST from users. For this purpose Authorised Pollution Testing Centers will upload GST registration in VAHAN portal and intimate the concerned RTO for approval. In the cases, where GST Registration Certificate details are available with RTO, he may upload the same in VAHAN portal against concerned Authorised Pollution Testing Center and accord approval.

It is hereby ordered that Authorised Pollution Testing Centers with GST registration uploaded and approved in VAHAN portal can only issue Pollution Under Control Certificate from 12.00 noon on 16.03.2020.
