It is expected that a large no. of sale of motor vehicles would occur during this auspicious Durga Puja. As per Rule 42 of CMV Rule 1989, no dealer can deliver any motor vehicle without its registration. Since, there are 4 Govt. holidays from 16.10.2018 to 19.10.2018 on the occasion of Durga Puja, it might be a difficult situation for the dealer to get their newly sold vehicle Registered at RTO offices.

In view of above it is hereby ordered that the Registration section of all RTOs shall remain open on 17.10.2018 & 18.10.2018 from 3 PM to 5 PM to receive the registration documents from dealer and allotment of registration number. The RTO shall make necessary roaster arrangement accordingly and also shall intimate to all the dealers under their jurisdiction regarding such facility.

In no case the dealers should deliver any new motor vehicle violating Rule 42 of CMV Rule 1989, without registration. All RTOs are instructed to check the dealer premises and ensure that, no vehicle is delivered with out registration. In case the dealer is delivering the vehicles without registration then steps shall be taken for cancellation or suspension of the trade license of the dealer.
