
Office Order

It is expected that a large no of sale of motor vehicles would occur during this auspicious Durga Puja. As per Rule 42 of CMV Rule 1989, no dealer can deliver any motor vehicle without its registration. Since, there are 4 Govt. Holidays from 21.10.2013 to 24.10.2023 on the occasion of Durga Puja, it might be a difficult situation for the dealer to get their newly sold vehicle Registered at RTO Offices.

In view of above, it is hereby ordered that the RTOs shall complete the verification and approval of new dealer point online registration record on the same day during the holidays.

In no case the dealers should deliver any new motor vehicle violating Rule 42 of CMVR 1989, without registration. In case, the dealer is delivering the vehicles without registration, then steps shall be taken for cancellation or suspension of the trade license of the dealer.




